The City of Salisbury Department of Infrastructure and Development and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) will be hosting an introductory session about the Army Corps' "Silver Jackets" program in Maryland, which is designed to provide information and support to disadvantaged, flood-prone communities in Maryland.

The City is helping with outreach to community stakeholders who are directly tied to the flood-prone areas within Salisbury, who are interested in participating in two or three community meetings about flooding in the City.

We are looking for potential stakeholders

who fall into one or more of the following categories:

- · Residents who live in flood-prone areas
- · Business owners/managers in flood-prone areas
- · Community leader(s) that are familiar with flooding problems
- Representatives from Haitian and Hispanic communities (that live/work in flood-prone areas)
- Representatives from overburdened or underserved communities (that live/work in floodprone areas)

The Maryland Silver Jackets Team first convened in 2010. The team's activities are guided by the **2016 State Hazard Mitigation Plan**.


Unity Square Music Series
