UPDATE: November 14, 2024 (Arrests -Assault/Hate Crime Investigation)

Three additional suspects were taken into custody as a result of the mid-October assault.

The Salisbury Police Department has charged three additional suspects for the incident that occurred on October 15, 2024 in the 1400 block of University Terrace wherein a victim was allegedly invited into a residence under false pretenses, assaulted while being called derogatory names, and not permitted to leave. At this time, all known suspects have been taken into custody.

As detectives continued their investigation, they identified 19-year-old Sean Antone of West Friendship, MD, 18-year-old Benjamin Brandenburg of Glyndon, MD, and 19-year-old Logan Clark of Severna Park, MD as also having allegedly taken part in the assault. Applications for charges were submitted to the District Court Commissioner's Office and arrest warrants were issued for all three men. Their charges mirrored those received by the twelve men previously arrested which included First Degree Assault, Reckless Endangerment, False Imprisonment, and Hate Crime associated offenses.

Mr. Antone was taken into custody by the Howard County Police Department on November 7, 2024 and processed in Howard County wherein he was taken before a District Court Commissioner. Members of the Salisbury Police Department took Mr. Brandenburg into custody on November 13, 2024. Mr. Clark turned himself into the Salisbury Police Department earlier this morning. Both Mr. Brandenburg and Mr. Clark were transported to the Wicomico County Detention Center to be seen by a District Court Commissioner.
