## **Yearly External Complaint Summary**

EC (External Complaint)- An internal investigation generated by complaint submitted by a member of the public.

**Administrative Charging Committee**- A five-member civilian board that reviews the police agency's internal investigation and determines as to whether or not to administratively charge a sworn police officer who is the subject of an investigation and recommend discipline.

**Trial Board**- Exists to serve law enforcement officers who wish to have a trial for charges brought by the Administrative Charging Committee and is composed of a three-member board consisting of a judge, a member of the public, and a law enforcement officer of equal rank to the charged officer.

**Sustained**- A violation of policy was determined to have occurred.

Not Sustained-Insufficient evidence was available to prove or disprove the allegation.

**Exonerated**- The incident occurred, however, the action taken was lawful and proper.

**Unfounded**- There was no evidence supporting the allegation.

Policy Failure- The police agency did not have a policy governing the alleged action.
