Winter Safety Tips from Dept. of Water Works

The Department of Water Works is committed to ensuring the wellbeing of our residents during the winter season by providing essential tips to protect your pipes from freezing.

- As temperatures drop below freezing, we recommend allowing cold water to drip from one faucet to prevent pressure buildup.
- Additionally, it is vital to turn off water from outdoor spigots, drain



all water from the lines, and install spigot covers for added protection.

- Insulating your crawlspace or basement can also safeguard your pipes from extreme cold.
- Have your HVAC units, fireplaces, and pellet-burning stoves cleaned and inspected annually to ensure safety and optimal performance.
- Lastly, maintaining a thermostat setting above 55 degrees can help keep your home safe during the winter months.

If you suspect that your pipes may have frozen, please turn off the main water line immediately and contact a plumber for assistance. We invite you to reach out with any questions or concerns regarding your water services.


