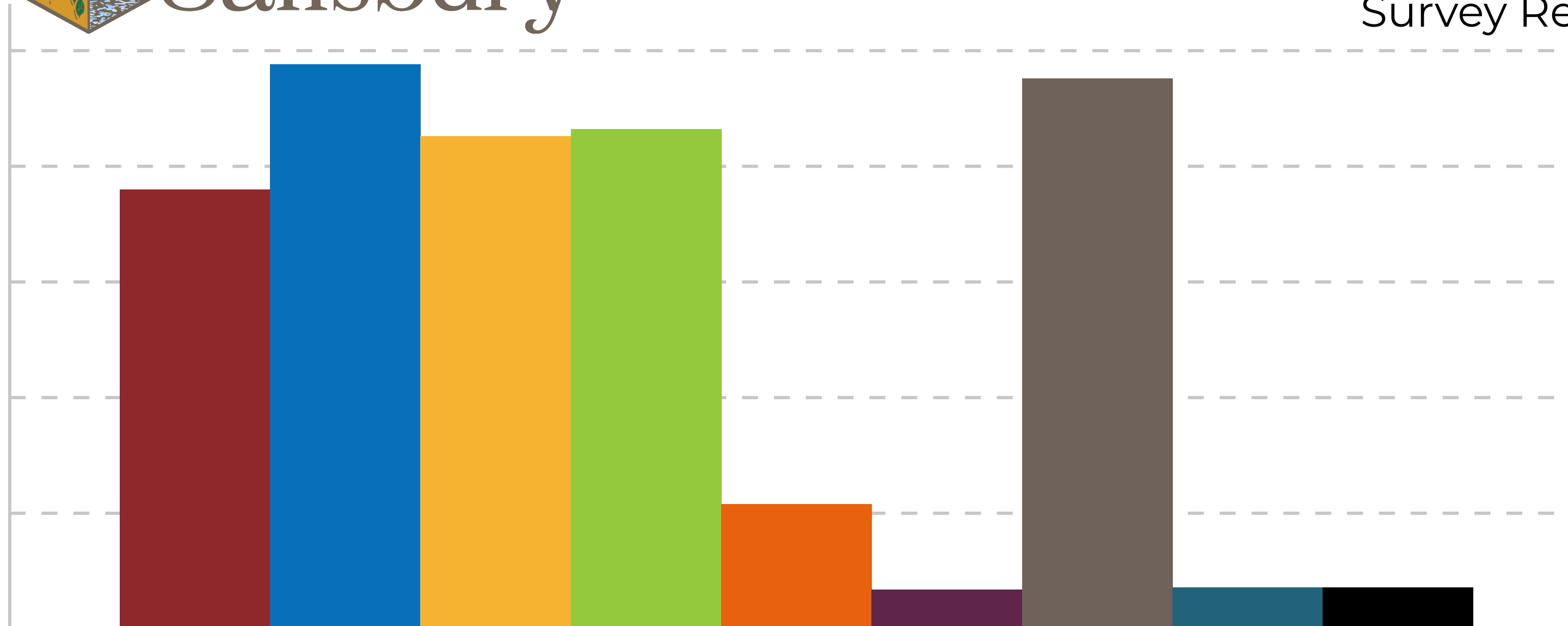

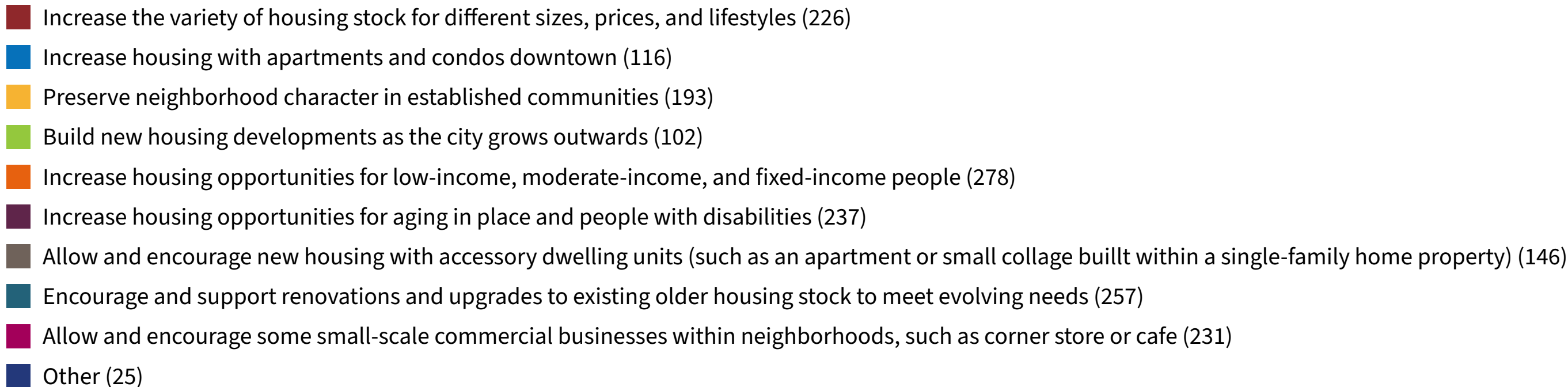

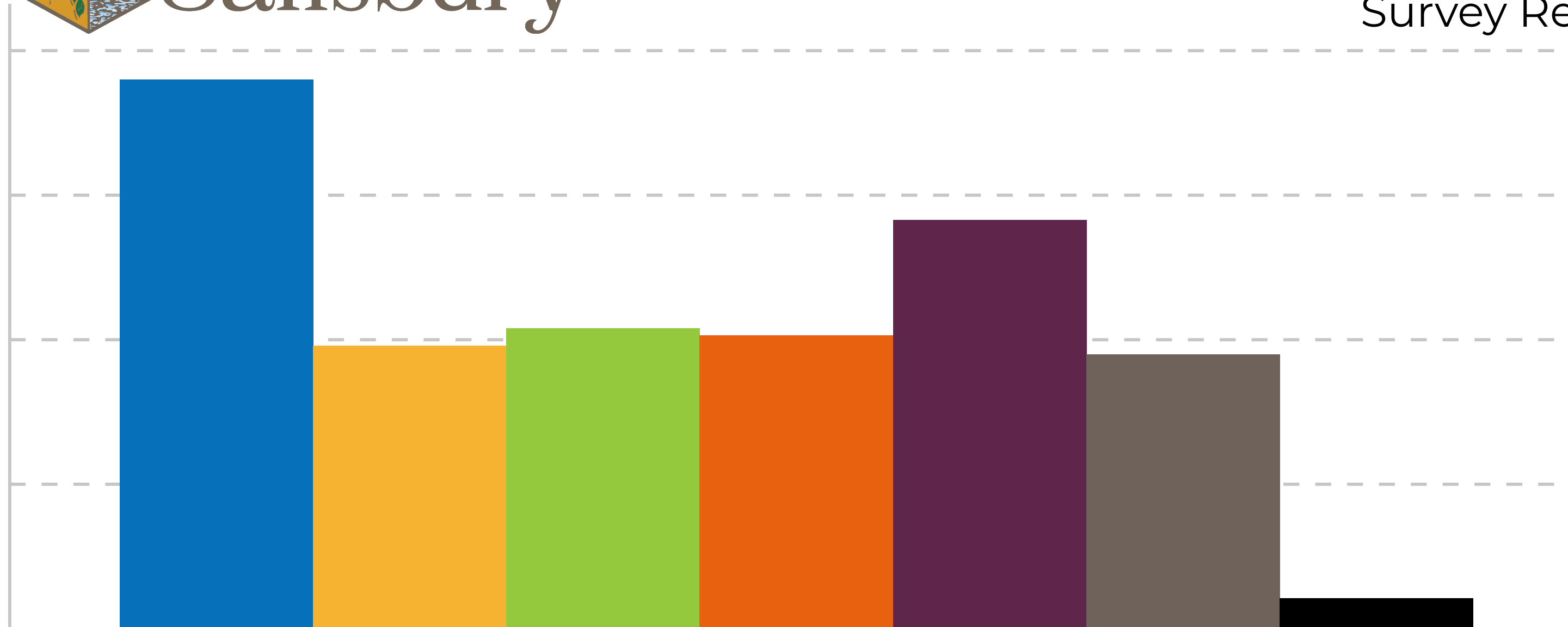

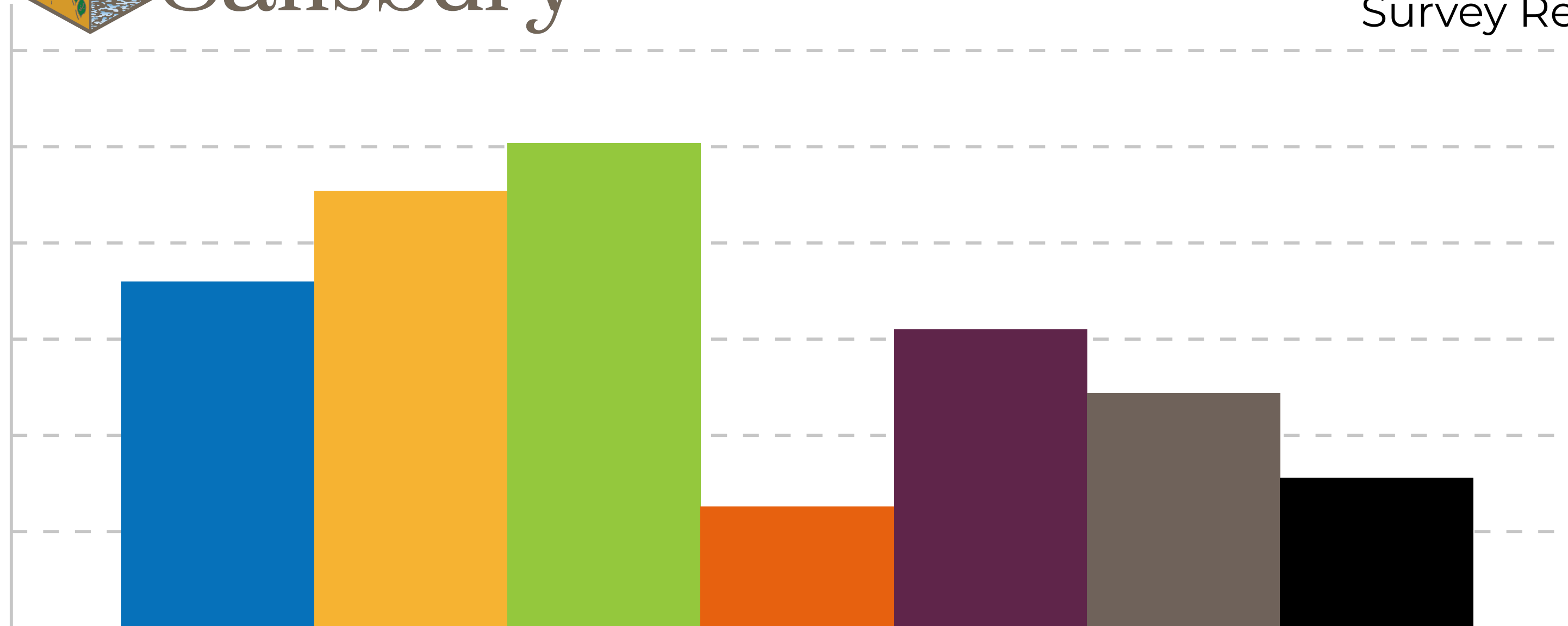

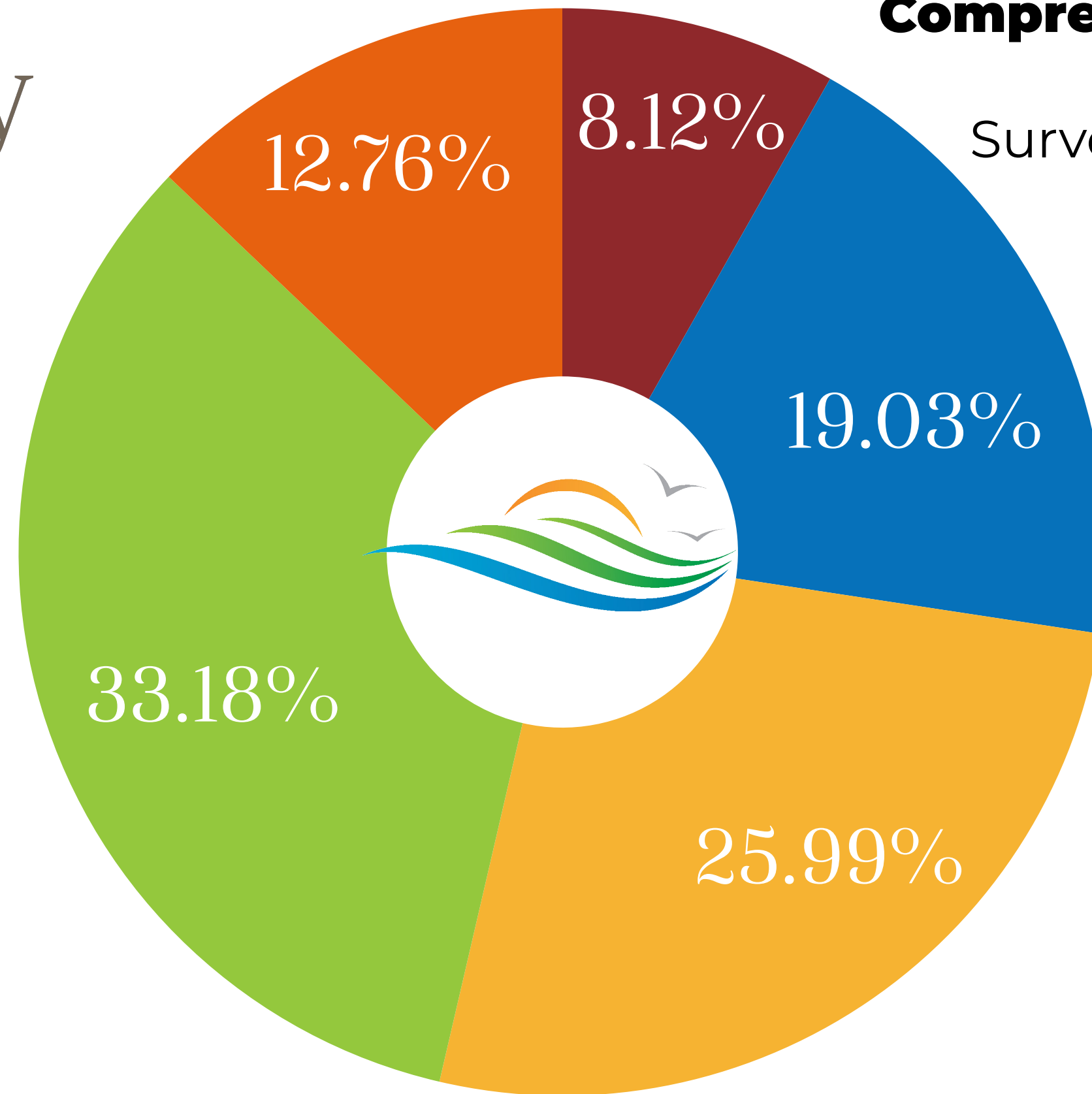
What should be the priorities for sustainability and resiliency in Salisbury?

- Upgrade and repair old infrastructure like streets, bridges, and drainage systems (354)
- Reduce flood risks with more green space to absorb run-of and buffer development from high tides (272)
- Increase tree canopy to provide more shade when there is hot weather (218)
- Reduce water pollution with better stormwater management and erosion controll (273)
- Encourage more use of renewable energy (218)
- Encourage more electrification of vehicle fleets and other systems that consume fossil fuels (113)
- Encourage people to drive less with better opportunities to walk, bike, and take transit (202)
- Develop emergency preparedness and evacuation plans in case of a major storm event (153)

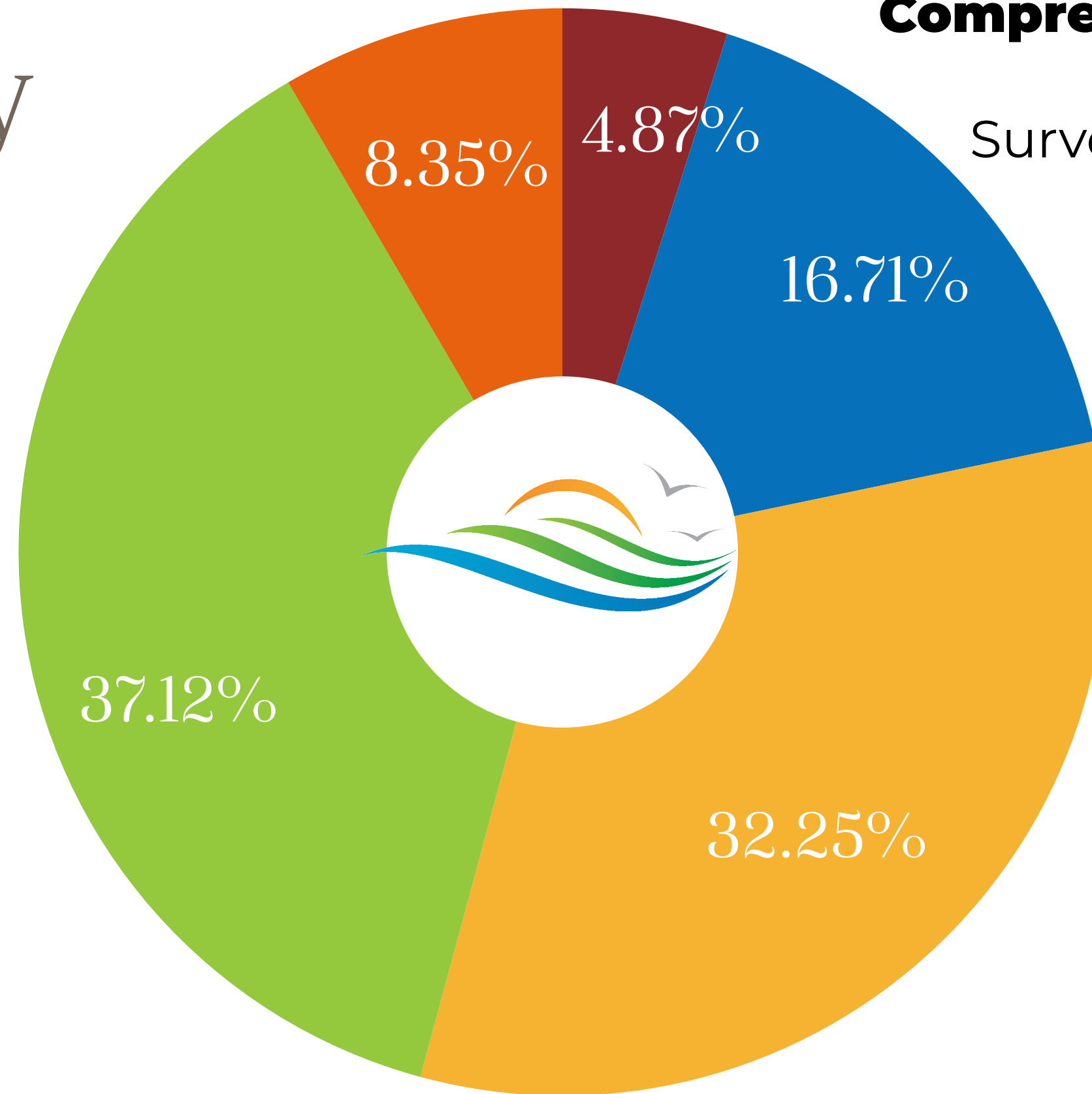

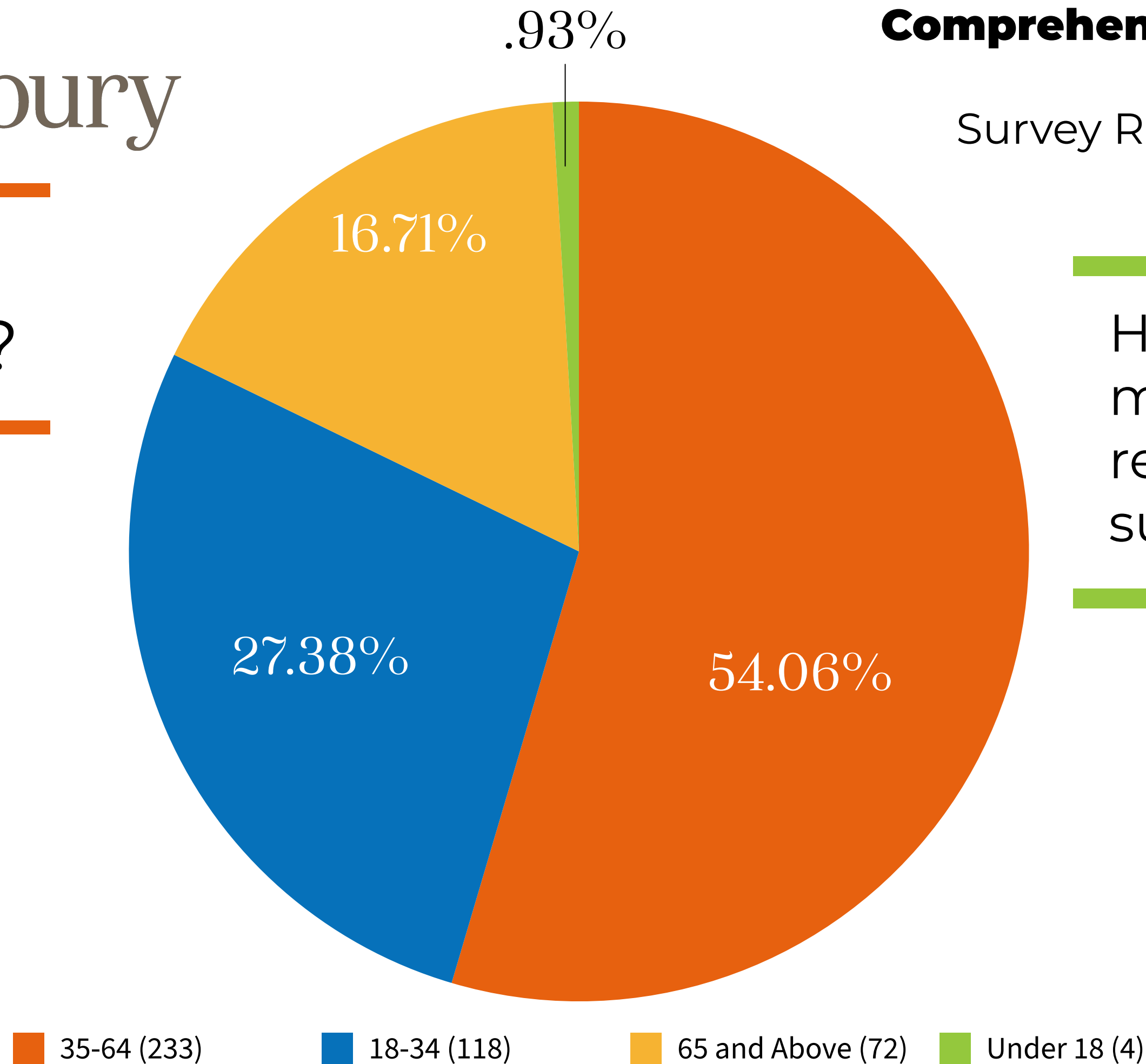

## What is your Age?

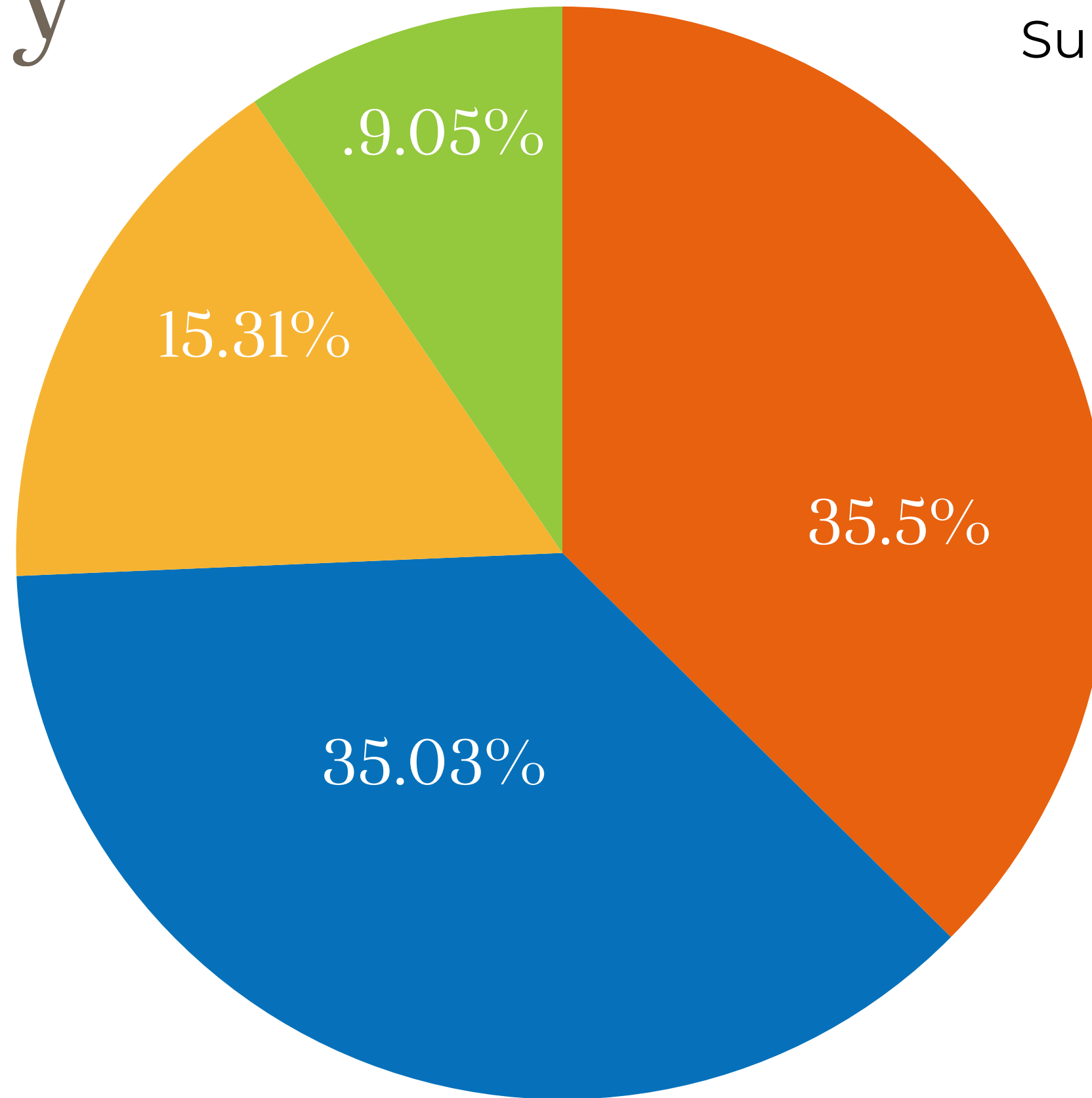

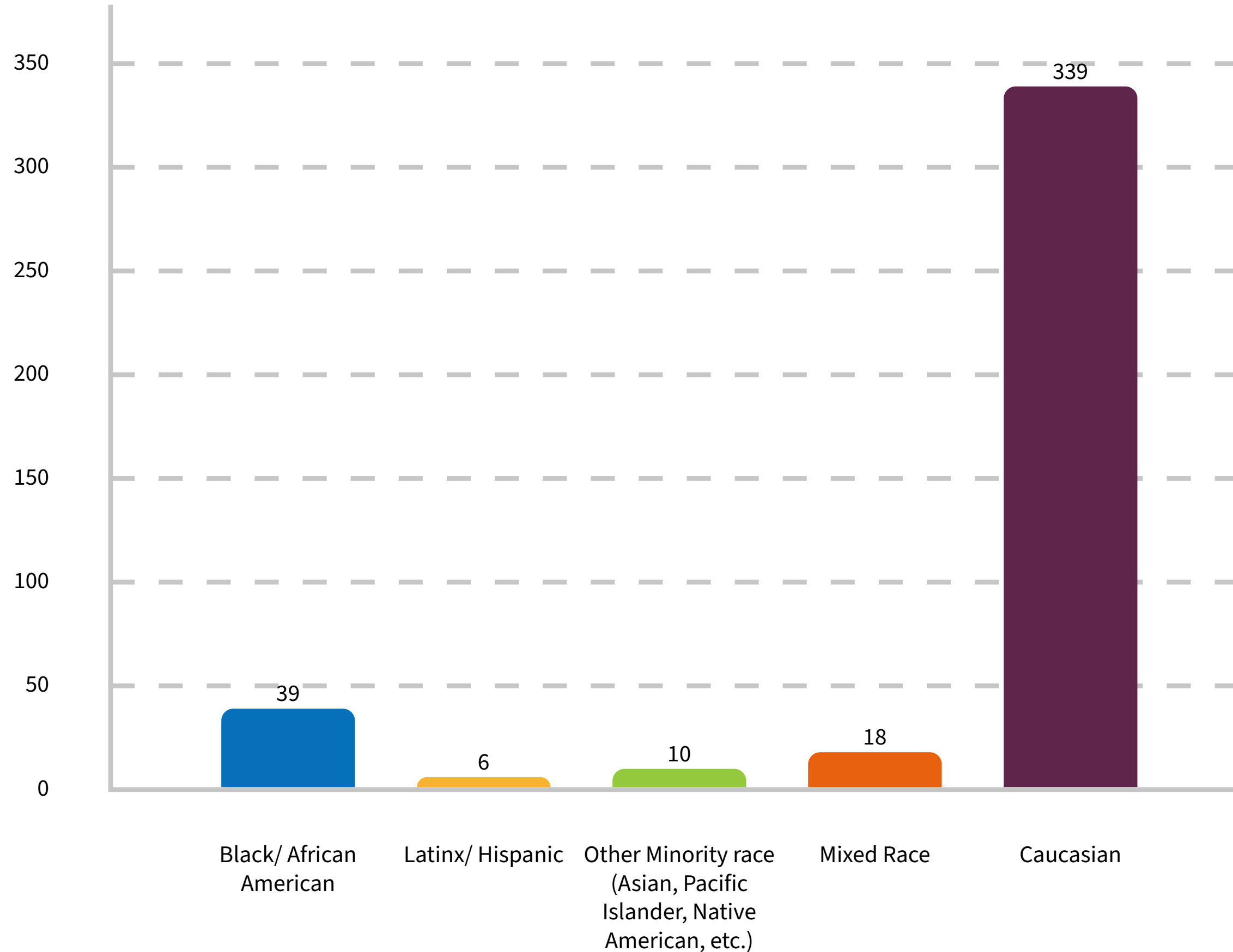
## What is your household income?

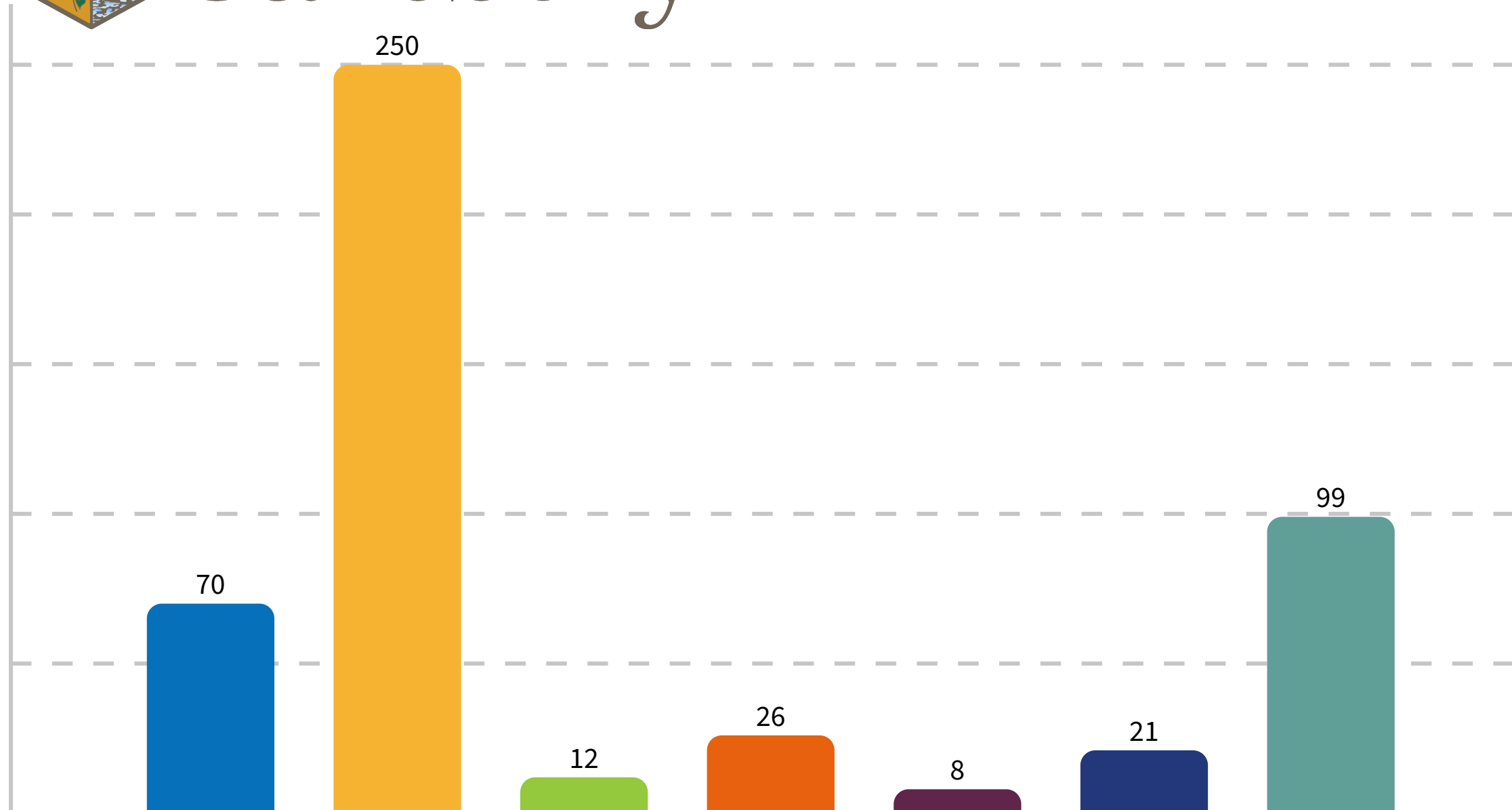
