## May 2, 2025 (Arrest- Shooting Investigation)

Salisbury Police arrest a St. Michael's man for a shooting incident that occurred last Friday in the 600 block of North Division Street.

On April 24, 2025, at approximately 10:45 in the evening, the Salisbury Police Department received multiple calls for shots fired within the 600 block of N. Division Street. Upon arrival, patrol officers learned two nearby residences, occupied by several people, had been struck with apparent gunfire. It was also learned that a canine inside one of the residences had been struck and killed during the incident.

The investigation revealed that 30-year-old Ri'tell Dodd allegedly fired a handgun in the direction of residences within the 600 block of N. Division St. An application for charges was submitted to the District Court Commissioner's Office and an arrest warrant was issued. With the assistance of the St. Michaels Police Department, investigators were able to locate Mr. Dodd and safely take him into custody on April 30, 2025. Mr. Dodd was brought back to Wicomico County and later released to the Wicomico County Detention Center to be seen by a District Court Commissioner.

The Salisbury Police Department would like to thank the St Michael's Police Department for their assistance in this investigation.
