Duties and Responsibilities

Administration/Department Administration: Holds self-accountable for assigned responsibilities; sees tasks through to completion in a timely manner.

- Work with animal care staff toward maintaining a high standard of animal welfare for the Zoological population
- Prepare diet for specified animals
- Provide husbandry for designated animal habitats
- Conduct daily observations on animals for atypical behavior, illness, and/or injury
- Facilitate behavioral husbandry goals utilizing enrichment and operant conditioning methods
- Communicate with Collections Curator about maintenance and/or habitat needs

Skills Proficiency/Strategic Planning: Skillful in use of tools, hardware, software, and equipment.

- Assists with maintenance of facility & grounds, as needed
- Demonstrates ability to safely and efficiently utilize basic hand tools
- If over the age of 21, safely & appropriately follow instructions on driving city vehicles
- Performs other duties as assigned

Leadership/Team Leader: Acts a role model and peer leader among their teammates and colleagues.

- Works with the Zoo team, which consists of a Director, Collections Curator, Registrar, Animal Care, Groundskeepers, Maintenance, Education Department, Veterinary team, Development Supervisor, and Administrative Assistant.
- Collaborates with the teams of other City departments and stakeholder groups

Stewardship: Safeguards equipment, supplies and material.

- Educates guests on the importance of the Salisbury Zoo, its relation to the city and the zoological industry as a whole
- Regularly observes the Zoological population and interprets what they observe
- Work closely with the animal care, veterinary and maintenance staff to successfully complete projects

Development/Leadership Development: Participate in opportunities to earn or maintain professional credentials and certifications.

- Attend opportunities and/or training for department staff to engage in professional development, career advancement and other City initiatives to improve interdepartmental relations
- Works on improving leadership skills by attending relevant meetings and trainings

Performance Expectations

Communication: Articulates thoughts and ideas clearly and effectively to exchange information. Listens to others and provides useful feedback.
