



Position Profile: Under the general supervision of the assigned supervisor, directs and manages wastewater treatment plant operators and the operation of the plant to ensure safety, efficiency, and compliance with regulatory discharge requirements. Preforms other duties as assigned.

Duties and Responsibilities

Administrative Management: Holds self-accountable for assigned responsibilities; sees tasks through to completion in timely manner.

- Oversees the operation of the 5A wastewater treatment plant, and makes decisions on process controls to keep the plant operating at peak efficiency.
- Generates monthly reports for Maryland Department of the Environment and the EPA based on daily records and associated calculations.
- Supervises operations section employees, conducts interviews, hires and trains employees, plans, assigns, and directs the work of subordinates.
- Orders supplies, equipment, and verifies invoices for accuracy.
- Monitors quality control equipment and procedures to ensure efficiency and compliance to state and federal regulations.
- Monitors and records chemical feed rates, calibrated chemical feed pumps, and troubleshoots equipment.
- Manages the plant's safety, MSDE program, coordinates training, responds to inspections, and maintains safety files.
- Maintains and updates the treatment plant reference library.
- Maintains and updates a variety of operations section records and logs.
- Operates the plant in the absence of available personnel.
- Keeps supervisor informed of new products or technology as well as any unusual or detrimental conditions including equipment malfunctions and process problems.

Skills Proficiency/Strategic Planning: Skillful in tools, hardware, software, equipment, and policies and procedures of the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

- Working knowledge of City policies and procedures.
