ORDINANCE NO. 2948

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ACCEPT A \$500 DONATION FROM THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF THE EASTERN SHORE TO FUND A GARDEN PLANTING AT ANNE STREET VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury's Housing and Community Development Department is holding an Anne Street Village garden planting; and

WHEREAS, the Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore wishes to provide grant funds to help this program; and

WHEREAS, the donation of funds will be used to purchase vegetable and herb plants, to be placed in the large container gardens at Anne Street Village; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations necessary to execute the purpose of the aforementioned donation must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Salisbury's Special Revenue Fund be and hereby is amended as follows:

- 1) Increase Contribution Revenue 10530–456423–xxxxx by \$500.
- 2) Increase Operating Expenses 10530-546006-xxxxx by \$500.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

- <u>Section 2</u>. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.
- <u>Section 3</u>. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.
- <u>Section 4.</u> The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 4.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 28 day of July, 2025 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, in the meantime, was finally passed by the Council of the City of Salisbury on the 11 day of August, 2025.
