

**ORDINANCE NO. 2981**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE DONATED FUNDS FROM THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF THE EASTERN SHORE TO SUPPORT THE COST OF SALISBURY CITY PARK PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE RESTORATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City's Department of Infrastructure and Development is preparing to restore the city park bridge; and

**WHEREAS**, The Community Foundation of the Eastern Shore administers a fund to support the cost of the city park bridge restoration; and

**WHEREAS**, The fund has an available balance of \$26,041.75; and

**WHEREAS**, The donated funds will be used for existing bridge handrail assembly demolition and refurbishment, new bridge handrail assembly installation, bridge undercarriage surface finish and vertical struts, bridge decking cleaning, and bridge overall finish; and

**WHEREAS**, appropriations necessary for this donation must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND**, as follows:

**Section 1.** The City's Special Revenue Fund be and hereby is amended as follows:

- 1) Increase Donations Revenue Account 10700-456415-xxxxx by \$26,041.75
- 2) Increase Construction Expense Account 10700-513026-xxxxx by \$26,041.75

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND**, as follows:

**Section 2.** It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.


**Section 3.** It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.

**Section 4.** The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 4.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.


