

ORDINANCE NO. 2982

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ACCEPT FUNDS RECEIVED FROM SUSTAINABLE MARYLAND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000 AS AWARDED TO ENACT THE POLLINATOR PATHWAYS PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF SALISBURY.

WHEREAS, Sustainable Maryland has an Action Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury submitted a grant application to Sustainable Maryland for funding to support the City of Salisbury's "Pollinator Pathways: Expanding Urban Habitat Through Education, Partnerships, and Demonstration" Program; and

WHEREAS, Sustainable Maryland has awarded the City funds in the amount of \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, all funds shall be used to accomplish the specified goals stated in the application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury must expend all grant funds within one (1) year of the date of the award letter, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury must submit through WizeHive a final report on fund usage within one (1) year of receiving the award; and

WHEREAS, § 7-29 of the Salisbury City Charter prohibits the City from entering into a contract that requires an expenditure not appropriated or authorized by the Council of the City of Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, appropriations necessary to execute the purpose of this grant must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. Mayor Randolph J. Taylor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with Sustainable Maryland on behalf of the City of Salisbury, for the City's acceptance of grant funds in the amount of \$20,000.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that

Section 2. The City of Salisbury's Grant Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

Increase Sustainable Maryland Revenue Account 10500-424960-XXXXX by \$20,000

Increase Operating Expense Account 10500-546006-XXXXX by \$20,000

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 3. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.

Section 4. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.


Section 5. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 5.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.


