

RESOLUTION NO. 3466

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ACCEPT AND
DECLARE AS SURPLUS TWO FORFEITED VEHICLES.**

WHEREAS, the Circuit Court of Wicomico County has forfeited to the City of Salisbury Police Department a 2014 Buick Verano, Vehicle Identification Number 1G4PP5SK0E4154757 ("Automobile 1"), and a 2007 Cadillac CTS, Vehicle Identification Number 1G6DP577870196683 ("Automobile 2"), pursuant to plea agreements in Case No. C22-CR24-000408 and Case No. C22-CR24-000353; and

WHEREAS, Automobile 1, a 2014 Buick Verano bearing Vehicle Identification Number 1G4PP5SK0E4154757, has an approximate value of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000); and

WHEREAS, Automobile 2, a 2007 Cadillac CTS bearing Vehicle Identification Number 1G6DP577870196683, has an approximate value of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000); and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department has determined that the vehicles are not needed for departmental operations; and

WHEREAS, the cost to bring these vehicles into compliance with Maryland State Inspection standards outweighs the value of use; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Salisbury to declare the vehicles surplus property and dispose of them through public auction in accordance with City policy and applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds from the sale of surplus vehicles should be appropriated to the Salisbury Police Department Vehicle Maintenance Budget to support ongoing vehicle maintenance and operational needs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Salisbury shall accept "Automobile 1", a 2014 Buick Verano bearing Vehicle Identification Number 1G4PP5SK0E4154757 and "Automobile 2", a 2007 Cadillac CTS bearing Vehicle Identification Number 1G6DP577870196683, from the Circuit Court of Wicomico County and the Mayor or his designee shall work with the City Solicitor to execute any documents necessary to process the title work and surplus for the automobiles.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 2. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Resolution shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.

Section 3. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.


Section 4. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Resolution as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 4.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.


THIS ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced, read, and passed at a Meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 23 day of March, 2026.
