

ORDINANCE NO. 2997

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S CAPITAL PROJECT FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE CITY PARKING GARAGE STRUCTURE REPAIR.

WHEREAS, the City's Department of Infrastructure and Development is preparing to repair the City parking garage structure; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department has determined that \$35,000 is available in unallocated interest earned on proceeds of the City's Public Improvement Bonds of 2019 issued in the original aggregate principal amount of \$11,225,000 (the "2019 Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used for the City's parking garage structure repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. The City's Capital Projects Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 2. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.

Section 3. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.

Section 4. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 4.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage and its approval by the Mayor.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on this 11 day of May, 2026, and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published or posted as required by law, was finally passed by the Council on the 26 day of May 2026.

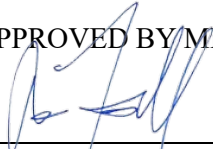
