

ORDINANCE NO. 3005

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ACCEPT FUNDS AWARDED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INSURANCE TRUST (LGIT) FOR THE CITY OF SALISBURY DEPARTMENT OF FIELD OPERATIONS' IMPLEMENTATION AND EXPANSION OF VEHICLE MONITORING SOFTWARE.

WHEREAS, the Department of Field Operations has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$10,000.00 from the Local Government Insurance Trust (LGIT); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this grant is to support the implementation and expansion of the City's vehicle monitoring (telematics) program to enhance fleet management capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the expansion of vehicle monitoring software will improve operational efficiency, strengthen oversight of City assets, enhance driver safety, and support data-driven maintenance and operational decisions; and

WHEREAS, the City has received or will receive these grant funds and must appropriate them within the Grant Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Field Operations requests that these funds be allocated to the Grant Fund for the implementation of this program; and

WHEREAS, the budget amendment as provided herein must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. The City of Salisbury's Grant Fund be and is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) Increase the LGIT Revenue Account 10500-456944-xxxxx by \$10,000.00; and
- (b) Increase the Equipment Expense Account 10500-577030-xxxxx by \$10,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 2. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.

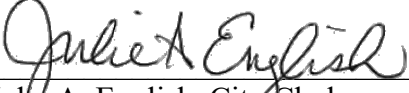
Section 3. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional, or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.

Section 4. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 4.

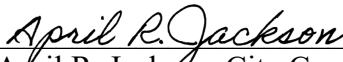
Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 26 day of May, 2026 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, in the meantime, was finally passed by the Council of the City of Salisbury on the 8 day of June, 2026.

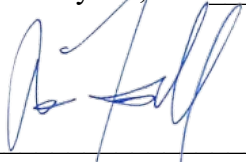
