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ORDINANCE NO. 3009

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING A
BUDGET AMENDMENT OF THE FY2026 GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO
INCREASE REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES ASSOCIATED WITH THE
CITY'S RED-LIGHT AND SPEED CAMERA PROGRAMS.**

WHEREAS, the FY2026 General Fund Budget included revenue and expenditures associated with the City's automated traffic enforcement programs; and

WHEREAS, during FY2026, the City implemented a new contract for speed camera services and expanded its automated traffic enforcement program through the activation of red-light cameras; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the revised contractual terms and the addition of red-light camera operations, administrative fees and vendor service costs associated with the automated traffic enforcement programs are projected to exceed the amount originally budgeted; and

WHEREAS, revenue generated from red-light and speed camera citations is projected to exceed the amount originally budgeted and is sufficient to offset the additional administrative and vendor service costs; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations necessary to increase both revenue and expenditures in the FY2026 General Fund Budget as provided herein must be made upon the recommendation of the Mayor and approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. Mayor Randolph J. Taylor is hereby authorized to appropriate additional revenue derived from red-light and speed camera citations and to expend such funds for administrative fees and vendor service costs associated with the City's automated traffic enforcement programs, in the amount of \$300,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 2. The City of Salisbury's FY26 General Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

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Section 3. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.

Section 4. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid,

46 unconstitutional, or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication
47 shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other
48 provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.
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50 **Section 5.** The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as
51 if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 5.
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53 **Section 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.
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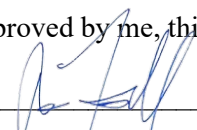
55 **THIS ORDINANCE** was introduced and read at a Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of
