

ORDINANCE NO. 3010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT AND THE TRANSFER OF STORM WATER UTILITY PAYGO FUNDING FROM THE NORTHWOOD AND BREWINGTON PROJECT TO THE CITY PARK PHASE I PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has determined that funding is needed for the City Park Phase I Project to support project planning, design, construction, and related improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that stormwater management requirements and opportunities associated with the City Park Phase I Project will need to be evaluated and addressed as part of the project's design and implementation; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$160,000 is currently available within the Storm Water Utility funded Northwood and Brewington Project and can be reallocated to support the City Park Phase I Project; and

WHEREAS, the appropriations necessary to execute this budget amendment as provided hereinabove must be made upon recommendation of the Mayor and the approval of four-fifths of the Council of the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 1. Mayor Randolph J. Taylor is hereby authorized to appropriate and transfer Storm Water Utility Paygo funds in the amount of \$160,000 from the Northwood and Brewington Project to the City Park Phase I Project.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 2. The City of Salisbury's Storm Water Utility Fund Budget be and hereby is amended as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, as follows:

Section 3. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that each provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein.

Section 4. It is further the intention of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable under applicable Maryland or federal law, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain and shall be deemed valid and enforceable.

Section 5. The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this section of the Ordinance as if such recitals were specifically set forth at length in this Section 5.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced and read at a Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Salisbury held on the 27 day of July, 2026 and thereafter, a statement of the substance of the Ordinance having been published as required by law, in the meantime, was finally passed by the Council of the City of Salisbury on the 10 day of August, 2026.

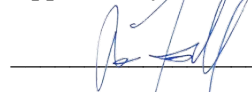
