Call to Order

- Meeting called to order by Elise. Attendees introduced themselves and engaged in a brief ice breaker.

Approval of Minutes

- June minutes approved (Motion: Sarah; Second: Christina; Approved)

Social Media

- Christina will establish a Hootsuite account and a Green Team Gmail account to support collaborative social media management.
- The social media team will include Elise, Christina, and Brooke.
- Elise will share the existing photo folder with members for use in future posts.
- The committee will aim to publish one high-quality social media post per week.
- Members are encouraged to send relevant content to Green SBY for reposting.

Community Gardens

- A technical issue is affecting the Lower Shore Land Trust's Shore Blooms registration form. Elise will meet with LSLT to determine a solution.
 - Approximately \$9,000–\$10,000 remains in grant funding. Funds will support a meadow installation at Lower Shore Enterprises this fall and additional pollinator gardens next spring.
 - Noah suggested incorporating less commonly used native plants, including lupine and Turk's cap lilies.
 - The committee discussed creating a more structured process for community members to request future pollinator garden installations.
 - The Amphitheater/Riverwalk area was identified as a potential location for a future meadow. The committee will hold its August meeting at the Amphitheater to evaluate the site.
