A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FEDERAL FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT TO ENHANCE THE COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, this is the eighth year of a local law enforcement block grant awarded by the federal government to reduce crime and improve public safety;

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has agreed to provide a local cash match of funds;

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department intends to maintain high availability technology of the Department's data communication network;

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department will obtain a technological upgrade of the Department's data communication network to provide daily information on crime statistics and crime prevention information which will increase security of the Department's internal data network;

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to enhance the Salisbury Police Department's website.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the awarded federal block grant funds in the amount of \$36,520 be accepted to enhance the communications network of the Police Department.
