Resolution No. 1173

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY RESTRICTING PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF LOCUST TERRACE INCLUDING THE CUL-DE-SAC, IN SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the number of vehicles parking on Locust Terrace has increased, causing an inconvenience for some of the residents;

WHEREAS, several residents of Locust Terrace have expressed a desire to restrict parking on the south side of the street, to include the cul-de-sac;

WHEREAS, a petition has been submitted containing the signatures of six residents to create a No Parking zone on Locust Terrace to reduce the inconvenience caused by an increase in vehicles parking on the street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the south side of Locust Terrace, including the cul-de-sac, be restricted to "No Parking".

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on _____, 2004, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
