The Council has enacted three Charter amendments this fiscal year – amending the recall provisions, providing for a City Administrator and modifying the required frequency of Council meetings. Charter amendments are required to be published four times.

In order to process the payment of the invoice for the last Charter amendment (frequency of Council meetings), monies will need to be transferred into the advertising account of the City Council's budget. As of this date, only \$11.83 remains in this account.

A Resolution is attached requesting approval of a \$1,000 transfer from the City Contingency Fund to cover the expense.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 1221**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE CITY'S CONTINGENCY TO THE CITY COUNCIL'S ADVERTISING BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council may allocate funds to the various offices, departments or agencies of the City of Salisbury from the City Contingency Fund pursuant to \$SC7-28(B) of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, additional funding of \$1,000 is required in the advertising budget of the City Council to cover expenses associated with the required publication of Charter amendments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby approve the following transfer from the City's Contingency Fund:

- 1. Decrease Account #90500-559500 (City Contingency) by \$1,000; and
- 2. Increase Account #11000-555501 (City Council Advertising) by \$1,000.
