

Resolution No. 1285

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY INCREASING THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF PARKING FINES TO ENCOURAGE CITIZENS TO ADHERE TO PARKING REGULATIONS IN SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention to the Mayor and Council that the dollar amounts of parking regulations are so insufficient that citizens are not compelled to adhere to the law;

WHEREAS, it has been recommend that parking fines be raised to \$10.00 for meters and permit violations;

WHEREAS, it has been further recommended that the additional \$15.00 parking violations which are noted on the parking violation citation be increased to \$35.00;

WHEREAS, the increase in fines is intended to encourage citizens to adhere to parking regulations in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the parking fines be raised to \$10.00 for meters and permit violations and the additional \$15.00 parking violations, which are noted on the parking violation citation, be increased to \$35.00.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on _____, 2005, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
