

Resolution No. 1288

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FUNDS IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE TO PROVIDE FOR OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT TO POLICE OFFICERS PARTICIPATING IN A SPECIAL SCHOOL BUS SAFETY PROGRAM TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES THAT ILLEGALLY PASS SCHOOL BUSES ON ROADWAYS IN MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the Department of State Police and the Salisbury Police Department will cooperate successfully in serving the people of Salisbury/Wicomico County and;

WHEREAS, grant funding has been designated for proactive enforcement efforts targeting vehicles that illegally pass school buses on roadways in Maryland;

WHEREAS, this is a unique opportunity for law enforcement, the local school board, and the community to work together in a partnership to increase the level of safety provided to our children;

WHEREAS, the use of overtime funds will allow increased police presence to reduce the number of vehicles that illegally pass school buses on roadways in Maryland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that grant funds in the amount of \$5,000.00 be accepted and used for overtime reimbursement to increase the level of safety provided to our children by reducing the occurrence of drivers illegally passing school buses.
