

RESOLUTION No. 1293

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND PERMITTING AN EXTENSION OF THE SOUTH PERIMETER FENCE OF THE ZOO DIVISION TO ACCOMMODATE A SERVICE ROAD, AS PROPOSED IN THE ZOO MASTER PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Zoo has recently completed a comprehensive Master Plan;

WHEREAS, the Master Plan calls for a service road to be located along the south perimeter fence that will be used by zoo staff and service vehicles;

WHEREAS, the service road will reduce staff and vehicle traffic along pedestrian pathways;

WHEREAS, in order to install the service road, it will be advantageous to extend a 500-foot section of the Zoo's south perimeter fence by 15 to 20 feet into the buffer between the Zoo and South Park Drive, as creating the service road within the current perimeter will require the cutting of trees and will use property that has been proposed for new exhibits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council permits the extension of the south perimeter fence of the Zoo Division to accommodate a service road, as proposed in the Zoo Master Plan.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on _____, 2005 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
