

RESOLUTION NO. 1368

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO APPROVE A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PARKING RATES IN PARKING LOT #1 FOR A THREE MONTH TRIAL.

WHEREAS, the Central City District Commission has proposed extending the free parking in Lot #1 from 1 hour to 2 hours to encourage more customers to come downtown to conduct business; and

WHEREAS, the CCDC has discussed this during the October 11, 2005, November 28, 2005, and the January 4, 2006 CCDC meetings and recommended this trial period; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a three month trial period be instituted to extend the free parking in Parking Lot #1 from one (1) to two (2) hours; and

WHEREAS, the hourly rate thereafter will be increased from the current rate of \$.50 per hour to \$1.00 per hour;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Salisbury approves this trial period for extension of free parking in Lot #1; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council agrees to the increase in hourly parking fees from current fee of \$.50 per hour to \$1.00 per hour for this trial period.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on Monday, February 27, 2006 and is to become effective on March 15, 2006.
