

Resolution No. 1373

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY TO ERECT A STOP SIGN ON THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF WEST DAGSBORO ROAD AND CHILI'S WAY IN SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, community concerns have been raised regarding the movement of traffic at the intersection of West Dagsboro Road and Chili's Way;

WHEREAS, confusion exists over the need for shopping center traffic west of this intersection to stop and yield to traffic on West Dagsboro Road;

WHEREAS, the erection of a stop sign will eliminate this confusion and provide for public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that a stop sign be erected on the southwest corner of the intersection of West Dagsboro Road and Chili's Way.
