

RESOLUTION NO. 1377

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING MATCHING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE MARYLAND INSTITUTE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEMS (MIEMSS) FOR UPGRADES TO TWO (2) PATIENT HEART MONITOR DEFIBRILLATORS USED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE DELIVERY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AND THE SALISBURY FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department desired to upgrade two (2) patient heart monitor defibrillators used for patient care and treatment; and,

WHEREAS, the Fire Department applied for matching grant funds from a program administered by the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS) designed to assist fire departments in offsetting the expenses of these equipment upgrades; and,

WHEREAS, the Fire Department was awarded matching grant funds in the amount of \$6,204.50 from the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS); and

WHEREAS, both the Fire Chief and the Mayor have recommended that the City accept these funds; and,

WHEREAS, City policy requires that grants funds can only be accepted with the approval of City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Salisbury accepts these matching grant funds and expresses its sincere appreciation to the Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems (MIEMSS) for its contribution to the City's efforts to further enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the services provided by the Fire Department to the citizens of the City and the Salisbury Fire District.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on Monday, March 13, 2006, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
