

RESOLUTION NO. 1406

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND APPROVING THE WAIVER OF OUTSTANDING LIENS AND AN OUTSTANDING WATER BILL TOTALING \$1,642.61 ON PROPERTIES LOCATED AT 213 AND 215 DAVIS ST. TO ASSIST HABITAT FOR HUMANITY IN PURCHASING AND REDEVELOPING THESE PROPERTIES FOR HOME OWNERSHIP

WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity has requested that the City waive outstanding liens and an outstanding water bill totaling \$1,642.61 on properties located at 213 and 215 Davis St. to assist Habitat for Humanity in purchasing and redeveloping these properties for home ownership; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City that these properties be redeveloped and that home ownership opportunities be expanded; and

WHEREAS, the purchase and redevelopment of these properties is a part of a larger effort by Habitat for Humanity to aid in the revitalization of the Church Street neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the City appreciates the continued efforts of Habitat for Humanity to assist in the revitalization of the City and to expand home ownership opportunities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council approves the waiver of outstanding liens and an outstanding water bill totaling \$1,642.61 on properties located at 213 and 215 Davis St. to assist Habitat for Humanity in purchasing and redeveloping these properties for home ownership; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council thanks Habitat for Humanity for its investment in the Church Street neighborhood and its efforts to expand home ownership opportunities.
