

RESOLUTION NO. 1424

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF TWO (2) PORTABLE WATERCRAFT FOR THE SALISBURY FIRE DEPARTMENT TO USE IN EFFORTS TO ENHANCE ITS CAPABILITIES IN PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT DELIVERY OF MARINE SURFACE AND SUB-SURFACE RESCUE OPERATIONS AND, TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AND THE SALISBURY FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the members of the Salisbury Fire Department, Inc. (Fire Station #16), seek to enhance the department's capabilities in the effective and efficient delivery of marine surface and sub-surface rescue operations; and,

WHEREAS, funds appropriated to the Volunteer Corporation (Salisbury Fire Department, Inc., Fire Station #16) have been expended by the Corporation to purchase two (2) portable watercraft to be donated to the City of Salisbury for inclusion in its inventory of emergency tools and equipment; and,

WHEREAS, both the Fire Chief and the Mayor have recommended that the City graciously accept the donation of the watercraft; and,

WHEREAS, the City's gift policy requires that such a gift can only be accepted with the approval of City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City of Salisbury accepts this gift and expresses its sincere appreciation to the membership of the Salisbury Fire Department, Inc. for their generous gift of the two (2) portable watercraft that enable the Salisbury Fire Department to further enhance the effectiveness and efficiency in its delivery of marine surface and sub-surface rescue operations to the citizens of the City and the Salisbury Fire District.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on Monday July 10, 2006, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
