

Resolution No. 1430

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING A SIXTEEN (16) CHANNEL AUDIOLOG RECORDER FROM THE EMERGENCY NUMBER SYSTEMS BOARD IN COOPERATION WITH THE WICOMICO COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES, TO PROVIDE QUALITY SERVICE TO ALL CITIZENS, REDUCING LOSS OF LIFE AND PROPERTY, GIVING EACH AND EVERY PERSON A SENSE OF SECURITY AND THE ASSURANCE THAT THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL BE READY AND ABLE TO MEET THE CHALLENGES ENCOUNTERED AND RESPOND TO THEIR NEEDS IN ANY EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Emergency Number Systems Board in cooperation with the Wicomico County Emergency Services will supply this agency with a sixteen channel Audiolog Recorder to enhance our ability to provide quality service to the citizens of Salisbury; and

WHEREAS, the existing recorder has experienced failure in recording and is difficult to ensure playback and retrieval of information; and

WHEREAS, this Audiolog Recorder is compatible with the existing infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the utilization of this sixteen channel (16) Audiolog Recorder will enhance communications and provide for the safety of the citizens of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the sixteen (16) channel Audiolog Recorder available free-of-charge from the Emergency Number Systems Board be accepted for use by the Salisbury Police Department.
