

RESOLUTION NO. 1460

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND APPROVING A COST SHARE AGREEMENT WITH THE MARYLAND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE FOR RECYCLING OF ELECTRONIC COMPONENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury is committed to encourage and support recycling of electronic components called eCycling; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has conducted very successful annual curbside eCycling events since 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury was the first municipality in the states of Maryland, Delaware, and Virginia; the Commonwealths of Pennsylvania and Virginia; and the District of Columbia to conduct curbside eCycling; and

WHEREAS, Maryland Environmental Service is offering to share the eCycling cost through a State of Maryland program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council approves the attached cost share agreement between the City of Salisbury and the Maryland Environmental Service to pay for the cost of disposing of the components collected.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on the 27th day of November, 2006 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
