

## Resolution No. 1468

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE MAXIMUM MONTHLY BENEFIT, ASSOCIATED COSTS, FOR THE LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARDS PROGRAM (LOSAP) FOR VOLUNTEER MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the volunteer members of the City of Salisbury Fire Department provide many hours of public safety services at great personal risk and for no financial remuneration; and

WHEREAS, in 1991 the City established a Length of Service Awards Program (LOSAP) to provide a benefit to the retired volunteer members of the Fire Department in recognition of their service to the City; and

WHEREAS, there have been no amendments, changes, or revisions to this program since its inception; and

WHEREAS, the volunteer members of the Fire Department have recommended an increase in the maximum monthly LOSAP benefit paid to retired volunteer members; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City and the volunteer members of the Fire Department to adopt their recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND, hereby agrees to:

1. Increase the maximum monthly LOSAP benefit from \$250.00 to \$500.00.
2. Annually consider funding the cost required to provide the maximum monthly benefits as prescribed by the program.
3. Authorize the Mayor of the City of Salisbury to sign the revised plan documents.

THIS RESOLUTION was duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on December 18, 2006 and is to become effective January 1, 2007.
