

RESOLUTION NO. 1479

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND TO APPROVE A NATIONAL PARK SERVICE PRESERVE AMERICA HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND GRANT TO PRESERVE AND PROMOTE AMERICA'S HERITAGE AND CULTURAL ASSETS.

WHEREAS, the National Park Service (NPS) has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Preserve America Grant Program for fiscal year 2006; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury is eligible to apply for funds from NPS; and

WHEREAS, funds will be requested to forward tourism efforts at Poplar Hill Mansion by hiring a marketing consultant to develop a marketing plan for this historic property; and

WHEREAS, the tourism site is located within a Preserve America Designated jurisdiction; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland does hereby authorize the submission of an application for Preserve America funds to forward the city's preservation and tourism initiatives; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, Mayor Barrie P. Tilghman is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for the submission of this grant application; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, copies of this Resolution will be sent to the Chief, Historic Preservation Grants Division of the National Park Service.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on January 22, 2007 and is to become effective immediately.
