

RESOLUTION NO. 1480

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SALISBURY, MARYLAND ADJUSTING THE SEPTAGE FEE

WHEREAS, the City and the County jointly established a Septage Facility in 1991 through the City/County Financing and Operating Agreement for Sludge Handling Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City/County Financing and Operating Agreement for Sludge Handling Facilities stipulates the City reimburse the County by raising the fee to recapture any County funded deficit to the operation of the Septage Facility; and

WHEREAS, the County Council recommends raising the Septage Fee from \$ 66 per thousand gallons to \$ 140 per thousand gallons and to review the level of revenue generated in six months; and

WHEREAS, the City Council instructed the City staff to prepare a resolution to raise the Septage Fee from \$ 66 per thousand gallons to \$ 140 per thousand gallons and to review the level of revenue generated in six months based on the County Council's recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council approves raising the Septage Fee from \$ 66 per thousand gallons to \$ 140 per thousand gallons effective February 1, 2007 and to review the revenue generated by the fee change after six months.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on _____, 2007, and is to become effective February 1, 2007.
