A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING STATE FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE MARYLAND POLICE AND CORRECTIONAL TRAINING COMMISSION GRANT TO CREATE AN NCIC REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER AT THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, this Maryland Police and Correctional Training Commission Grant is awarded by the state government to assist in the mandated training of personnel; and

WHEREAS, this grant award will be used to establish a local NCIC training center which would eliminate the need for time and travel expense for both sworn and civilian personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department intends to purchase and install a NCIC training computer lab, thereby, maintaining high availability technology of the Department's data communication network.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the awarded state grant funds in the amount of \$15,000 be accepted and those funds used to establish an NCIC computer lab for mandated training of personnel.
