

RESOLUTION NO. 1492

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING A TEMPORARY SINGLE LANE ROAD CLOSURE OF WEST ROAD FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND CONVENIENCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted rules for temporary road closure for the City's streets and highways to ensure public safety and convenience with Resolution No. 1023; and

WHEREAS, the owners of Westwood Commerce Park are installing sewer mains in the public rights of way of West Road, which will require a temporary road closure of approximately 90 days; and

WHEREAS, the City Council rules established in accordance with Resolution 1023 require a City Council resolution authorizing temporary road closures in excess of 31 days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council approves the temporary single lane road closure of West Road for a period not to exceed ninety calendar days in accordance with a traffic control plan submitted by McCrone, Inc. representing Westwood Commerce Park owners and approved by the Department of Public Works in accordance with the standards of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on ____ day of _____, 2007 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
