

RESOLUTION NO. 1515

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF ONE (1) FIREFIGHTING SKID UNIT FOR THE SALISBURY FIRE DEPARTMENT TO USE IN EFFORTS TO ENHANCE ITS CAPABILITIES IN PROVIDING EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT BRUSH, FIELDS, AND WOODS FIRE SUPPRESSION SERVICES TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AND THE SALISBURY FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the members of the Salisbury Fire Department, Inc. (Fire Station #16), seek to enhance the department's capabilities in the effective and efficient suppression of brush, fields, and woods fires: and,

WHEREAS, funds appropriated to the Volunteer Corporation (Salisbury Fire Department, Inc., Fire Station #16) have been expended by the Corporation to purchase one (1) brush firefighting skid unit to be donated to the City of Salisbury for inclusion in its inventory of emergency tools and equipment; and,

WHEREAS, both the Fire Chief and the Mayor have recommended that the City graciously accept the donation of the firefighting apparatus; and,

WHEREAS, City policy requires that such a gift can only be accepted with the approval of City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City of Salisbury accepts this gift and expresses its sincere appreciation to the membership of the Salisbury Fire Department, Inc. for their generous gift of one (1) firefighting skid unit that will enable the Salisbury Fire Department to further enhance the effectiveness and efficiency in its delivery of fire suppression services at brush, fields, and woods fire events for the citizens of the City and the Salisbury Fire District.
