

RESOLUTION NO. 1524

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FROM THE CITY'S CONTINGENCY FUND TO COVER AN OUTSTANDING INVOICE FROM TISCHLERBISE RELATED TO THE IMPACT FEE FEASIBILITY ANALYSIS.

WHEREAS, the City of Salisbury has a Contingency Fund established in § SC7-12G of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council may authorize the direct expenditure of the account for purposes not anticipated at the time of the budget adoption pursuant to § SC7-28 of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the outstanding invoice with the consulting firm TichlerBise, Inc. is \$7,500 for work satisfactorily completed in FY 2006; and

WHEREAS, the previously appropriated funds for this invoice were not expended and returned to the General Fund Surplus; and

WHEREAS, there are no additional funds in the FY 2007 budget to allow for this payment, and;

WHEARES, there is sufficient balance in the Contingency Fund to cover this invoice;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the expenditure of \$7,500 from the City Contingency Fund to cover the invoice from TichlerBise.

THIS ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury held on the _____ day of May, 2007, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
