

RESOLUTION NO. 1527

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY,
MARYLAND ENDORSING REQUESTS FOR LEGISLATIVE ACTION BY THE
MARYLND MUNICIPAL LEAGUE

WHEREAS, the Maryland Municipal League (MML) each year requests input from its member municipalities on items of interest to municipalities statewide that should be brought before the next session of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the MML reviews all requests received and selects several items, to which it will give priority support during the legislative session; and

WHEREAS, the following matters, which have statewide application, are of particular concern to the City of Salisbury and require legislative action;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council endorses the following requests for legislative action by the Maryland Municipal League:

- a) recommend approval of a gasoline tax exemption for municipal government use;
- b) remove all counties from the “may” category and require that they “shall” provide a property tax setoff where duplication of services is shown to exist.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on June 11, 2007, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
