

RESOLUTION NO. 1559

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF ONE (1) MAKO SCFS2-4HP HIGH PRESSURE BREATHING AIR CONTAINMENT FILL SYSTEM FOR THE SALISBURY FIRE DEPARTMENT TO USE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SAFELY AND EFFICIENTLY REFILLING SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS AIR CYLINDERS THEREBY ENSURING THE SAFETY OF THOSE MEMBERS IN THEIR EFFORTS TO PROVIDE EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT SERVICES TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AND THE SALISBURY FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the members of the Salisbury Fire Department, Company No. 1 Inc. (Fire Station #1), seek to enhance the department's capabilities in the effective and efficient delivery of public safety services; and,

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Corporation (Salisbury Fire Department, Inc., Company No. 1) has purchased one (1) MAKO SCFS2-4HP Breathing Air Containment Fill System; and,

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Corporation (Salisbury Fire Department, Inc, Company No. 1) desires to donate this system to the City of Salisbury for inclusion in its inventory of emergency tools and equipment; and,

WHEREAS, both the Fire Chief and the Mayor have recommended that the City graciously accept the donation of this equipment; and,

WHEREAS, City policy requires that such a gift can only be accepted with the approval of City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City of Salisbury accepts this gift and expresses it's sincere appreciation to the membership of the Salisbury Fire Department, Inc. Company No. 1, for their generous gift of one (1) MAKO SCFS2-4HP Breathing Air Containment Fill System that will enable the Salisbury Fire Department to further ensure the safety of those members in their efforts to provide effective and efficient services to improve the quality of life for the citizens of the City and the Salisbury Fire District.
