

RESOLUTION NO. 1560

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF ONE (1) STRYKER MX-PRO R3 BARIATRIC TRANSPORT COT FOR THE SALISBURY FIRE DEPARTMENT TO USE IN THE SAFE AND EFFICIENT MOVEMENT AND TRANSPORTATION OF BARIATRIC PATIENTS AND TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF FIRE DEPARTMENT MEMBERS IN THEIR EFFORTS TO PROVIDE EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT SERVICES TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY AND THE SALISBURY FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the members of the Salisbury Fire Department identified a need to acquire equipment that will permit personnel to safely move and transport bariatric patients; and,

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Corporations (Salisbury Fire Department, Inc., Company No. 1, Salisbury Fire Company No. 2 Inc, Salisbury Fire Department, Inc.) have purchased one (1) Stryker MX-PRO R3 transport cot; and,

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Corporations (Salisbury Fire Department, Inc., Company No. 1, Salisbury Fire Company No. 2 Inc., Salisbury Fire Department, Inc.) desire to donate this item to the City of Salisbury for inclusion in its inventory of emergency tools and equipment; and,

WHEREAS, both the Fire Chief and the Mayor have recommended that the City graciously accept the donation of this equipment; and,

WHEREAS, City policy requires that such a gift can only be accepted with the approval of City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City of Salisbury accepts this gift and expresses it's sincere appreciation to the volunteer membership of the corporations of the City of Salisbury Fire Department for their generous gift of one (1) Stryker MX-PRO R3 bariatric transport cot (Model 6083) that will enable the Salisbury Fire Department to safely move and transport bariatric patients while ensuring the safety of Fire Department members in their efforts to provide effective and efficient services to improve the quality of life for the citizens of the City and the Salisbury Fire District.

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on Monday September 10, 2007, and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
