

RESOLUTION NO. 1586

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY TRAVEL-LANE SHIFTS AND CLOSURES ON PARSONS ROAD AND PEMBERTON DRIVE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND CONVENIENCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted rules for temporary travel-lane shifts and closures for the City's streets and highways to ensure public safety and convenience with Resolution 1023; and

WHEREAS, the owners of Rite Aid are installing storm water, water, and sewer mains and widening the road in the public rights of way of Parsons Road and Pemberton Drive which will require temporary vehicular travel-lane shifts and closures of approximately 60 days in duration; and

WHEREAS, Nanticoke Road and part of Parsons Road which are state roads, will require temporary travel-lane shifts and closures subject to state approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Council rules established in accordance with Resolution 1023 require a City Council resolution authorizing temporary travel-lane shifts and closures in excess of 30 days for City roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council approves the temporary travel-lane shifts and closures on Parsons Road and Pemberton Drive for a period not to exceed sixty calendar days in accordance with a traffic control plan submitted by BL Companies representing Rite Aid and approved by the Department of Public Works in accordance with the standards of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).
