A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH A GRANT FROM THE TARGET CORPORATION TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE SALISBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, this grant is being awarded by the Target Corporation to purchase computer equipment (hardware & software) to be used by the Salisbury Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Salisbury Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division will use this computer equipment and software programs to enhance the thorough investigation of serious crimes and contribute to the successful prosecution of individuals accused of those crimes; and

WHEREAS, this equipment will be utilized by the Criminal Investigation Division to record, track and investigate suspects, evidence, crime scenes, victims, etc., and aid in the solution and prosecution of serious cases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND that the awarded grant funds in the amount of \$1,000 be accepted and used to purchase this computer equipment to increase investigator's capability of efficient and effective prosecution of cases.
