

RESOLUTION No. 1630

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY, MARYLAND ESTABLISHING NO ON-STREET PARKING ALONG WAYNE STREET AND AVERY STREET (BETWEEN BATEMAN STREET AND SOUTH DIVISION STREET).

WHEREAS, Wayne Street and Avery Street are existing City streets without accommodations for on-street parking (between S. Division Street and Bateman Street); and

WHEREAS, Salisbury University is experiencing shuttle-bus maneuverability problems from on-street parking by University students along both sides of Avery Street and Wayne Street which creates safety concerns for: students weaving through parked cars to cross the streets and vehicular traffic attempting to maneuver the resulting reduced width of the travel lanes; and

WHEREAS, Salisbury University has provided adequate parking-lot facilities along Avery Street and Wayne Street to accommodate University students; and

WHEREAS, Salisbury University is requesting the City to prohibit all on-street parking on Avery Street and Wayne Street (between S. Division Street and Bateman Street); and

WHEREAS, Wicomico County Public Works is experiencing difficulty with access to the Avery Street Recycling Center as a result of University students parking their vehicles along Avery Street adjacent to the recycling center and obstructing access by county equipment attempting to pick up recyclables and the general public attempting to drop off recyclables; and

WHEREAS, Wicomico County Public Works is requesting the City to restrict parking on Avery Street in the vicinity of the recycling center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland does hereby authorize the prohibition of on-street parking along both sides of Avery Street and Wayne Street (between S. Division Street and Bateman Street).

THE ABOVE RESOLUTION was introduced and duly passed at a meeting of the Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland held on _____, 2008 and is to become effective immediately upon adoption.
