

RESOLUTION NO. 1675

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALISBURY ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS AWARDED THROUGH THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL & PREVENTION TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENTS, DEMONSTRATING THE IMPORTANCE OF THE SCHOOL BUS SAFETY LAWS, TO BE SHOWN IN EVERY MOVIE THEATRE THROUGHOUT SALISBURY/WICOMICO COUNTY, FROM AUGUST 1, 2008 – SEPTEMBER 30, 2008.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention and the Salisbury Police Department will cooperate to successfully serve the citizens of Salisbury/Wicomico County; and

WHEREAS, grant funding has been designated for a media campaign of public service announcements, to demonstrate the importance of the School Bus Safety Laws and how these laws will be proactively enforced, to be shown in every movie theatre throughout Salisbury/Wicomico County; and

WHEREAS, this is a unique opportunity for law enforcement and the community to work in partnership to increase the level of safety provided to our children; and

WHEREAS, the use of these funds, for public service announcements, will educate the driving public by letting them know the seriousness of illegally passing school buses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Salisbury, Maryland to accept grant funds in the amount of \$3,264.00, to be used for public service announcements, to increase the level of safety provided to our children by reducing the occurrences of drivers illegally passing school buses.
