WHEREAS; the City's Employee Handbook provides that employees can only serve in acting status for terms exceeding six months with the advice and consent of the City Council; and


WHEREAS, Lieutenant Ivan Barkley has been serving in acting status since December 21, 2009 and is approaching the six month anniversary; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salisbury City Council hereby agrees to extend the acting status of Lieutenant Ivan Barkley ~~until a new Police Chief can be appointed~~ for up to an additional six months.

Section 0308 (C) of the City's Employee Handbook provides that an employee can only serve in an acting capacity for more than six months with the advice and consent of the City Council. Lieutenant Ivan Barkley was appointed Acting Police Chief effective December 21, 2009 and is approaching the six month anniversary.

The Mayor has not yet started the selection process for the Police Chief position and requests to continue acting status for Lt. Barkley until a new Police Chief can be appointed.
